



QVMX Supplementary regulations for Pre 90 for the year ending December 2010 inclusive. Publication date 23/01/2010

18.4.1 Class Identification

18.4.1.1 A letter will be:

- Used to identify the class of the machine,
- Placed on the left side of all 3 race plates,
- 50mm high, and in upper case,
- The same colour as the race number.

18.4.1.2 Identification letters for each class are:

- Pre-1960 "A".
 - Pre-1965 "N".
 - Pre-1968 "F".
 - Pre-1970 "H".
 - Pre-1975 "X".
 - Pre-1978 "Z".
 - Evolution "E".
 - Pre-1985 "Y"
- i) for QVMX Pre 90 the letter will be "Q" unless MA over rules this designator.

18.7.15.1 Pre 1990 class Hence forth will be referred to as "Pre 90"

18.7.15.2 Pre 90 eligibility. Acceptable machines for Pre 90 are machines built from Jan 1985 up to December 1989 including the 1989 models. IE a machine built as a 1990 model, built in 1989 is **not** eligible. There is **no** follow on rule to apply. This rule is applied in the spirit of vintage motocross.

18.7.15.3 Modifications using later equipment are not allowed. All components will be of the period the machine was manufactured. Excluding – Handle bars, levers, foot pegs, Exhaust system.

18.7.15.5 Classes the following class will be run.

(1) Pre 90 all powers, This class will run all the following classes, If insufficient numbers of bikes are entered they will compete as one class.

- Solo 125cc
- Solo 250cc
- Solo 263cc and over

18.7.15.6 Pre 90 class bike may only compete against the Pre 85 class in the event that the pre 90 class does not fill the minimum number for a race.

18.7.15.6a If Pre 90 Bikes are to compete with Pre85 bikes they will compete in their designated capacities.

- Solo 125cc
- Solo 250cc
- Solo 263cc and over

18.7.15.7 Rules 18.7.15.6 and 18.7.15.6a Will not apply to the single bike rider class.

18.7.15.8 No age group classes will be run.
